

## Who can refer young people to the Transition to Work service?

Young people can be referred to Transition to Work services through different pathways, reflecting the different circumstances of each young person. For example:

- Eligible young people will be referred to the Transition to Work service by the Department of Human Services (Centrelink) when they first claim income support.
- Eligible young people will be able to directly register with Brophy.
- Eligible young people may be referred to Transition to Work by a jobactive provider.

## Transition to Work



## Transition to Work is a service to support young people on their journey to employment.

The Transition to Work service will focus on developing each young person's unique skills and talents so they can achieve their learning and employment goals.

**Young people** will receive personalised coaching to develop a career action plan, find training that meets their goals, participate in real-world work or volunteering opportunities and gain employment.

**Employers** will receive ongoing support and assistance from Transition to Work to train, skill and recruit young employees to meet their business needs.

**Brophy, as a Transition to Work provider** has a great deal of experience working with young people, and has strong links with employers, community services and schools within the local community.

### Services for young people

The Transition to Work service will focus on equipping young people to become work ready through coaching, training and work experience opportunities.

The Transition to Work service can help young people:

- develop practical skills to get a job
- connect with education or training
- find and participate in work experience opportunities
- identify employment opportunities in the local area
- connect with relevant local community services.

### Services for employers

Transition to Work will support employers to ensure young people meet their business needs and are supported to settle into a job. Young people will receive pre-employment skills training that is directly relevant to the needs of employers.

Brophy will offer post-placement employer support. This includes regular contact to ensure the young person is settling in and that the employer's expectations are being met.

For eligible young people, a youth wage subsidy may be available to employers.



### Who is eligible for Transition to Work?

Transition to Work is targeted at early school leavers aged 15 to 21 years.

The service will also support some young people who have experienced difficulty transitioning from education to employment. This can include all eligible young people regardless of their income support status.
